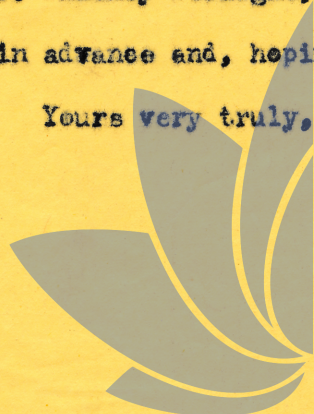
I just came in back from America and I am going to spend a few days in the Island of Minorca to shoot a few partridges.
